Access for delivery to site <u>must be</u> at least 2 feet wider than the width of the shed. Example: An 8'x10' shed requires an entrance of at least 10 feet.
A clear path of entrance and delivery is present. Obstructions, including but not limited to trees, shrubbery, pavers and other large objects are absent from the entrance, delivery, and set-up location. Adequate navigability for a flat-bed truck is required.
Any and all permits necessary and site preparation including leveling or installation of a pad are performed prior to shed delivery, if required and are the responsibility of the purchaser along with any expenses incurred.
14 feet minimum height clearance is required. Branch removal is the responsibility of the customer.
Any incline/decline or otherwise unlevel topography has been verified as accessible by purchaser.
Any obstructive gate, fencing or similar boundary is removed prior to delivery of the shed at the expense of the purchaser.
If delivery requires ingress or egress through a neighbor's property, written and signed permission for access is to be obtained by purchaser of structure.
Amish Woodworks is not responsible for any damage to the landscape due to weather conditions or delivery circumstances.
Any purchase cancellation of a shed order must be in writing and will result in a restocking fee, to be determined by Amish Woodworks.
